## The Prestonfield Reel

Dance for couple facing couple around the room 32 bar Reel, repeated ad lib Joining hands with partner, all advance and retire. 1-4 5-8 Dropping hands, all dance back-to-back (do-si-do) with the person 9-16 Joining hands in the sets of 4, all circle 4 hands round to the left and 17-20 All set to partner using any setting step (or other step) of choice. 21-24 All turn or spin partners by the right. Joining right hand in right hand, left hand in left hand with partner, 25-32 ladies on the right of their partner, all promenade at random around the room, finishing facing a new couple ready to start again.

Repeat ad lib.

This dance was written when I worked for IndigoVision plc, and was first danced at a company ceilidh in Prestonfield House, Edinburgh, on Saturday 5th May, 2001. At that point it was called "Seeing Purple".

I'm not convinced by the name, so it may change, and the dance may evolve as well...
